

The Pierre de Coubertin Award



School Nomination Information

- Students will be assessed and nominated by their school by the specified closing date
- Schools are encouraged to conduct an internal awards process to determine their nominee.
- Only ONE nomination will be accepted from each school in any one year.
- Special nominations for students with disabilities or students who are isolated will be considered by the Awards Committee.

Presentation

Certificates recognising Award recipients may be presented at an award ceremony during Olympic Awareness Week (the calendar week around 23rd June - International Olympic Day) at either school, district or state level, and / or forwarded directly to the Principal for a school presentation event.

Selection Criteria and Guidelines

The Award recipient must:

- Be enrolled in years 11 or 12 (Year 10 for Central Schools or Junior Colleges) and not have received the award on a previous occasion;
- Have participated actively in his/her school physical education program with a consistently positive attitude; and
- Demonstrate the attributes consistent with the fundamental aims of the Olympic movement

At some stage throughout years 7-12, the selected student must have represented his/her school in:

- Interschool competition in at least one of the following: Swimming, Athletics or Cross Country; and at least two other competitive sports (individual or team).
- The student must submit a piece of work (literary or artistic) which demonstrates / depicts an appreciation of Olympism.
Literary – Maximum of 250 words (typed)
Artistic – Maximum 64cm x 45cm (or equivalent in three dimensional context)



Checklist for Nomination

- Nomination Form completed by your Year Adviser and signed by your Principal.
- Literary work max 250 words (typed) / artistic work max 64cm x 45cm (or equivalent in three dimensional format) completed and attached to nomination.
- Entry submitted to the NSW Olympic Council by the specified closing date.

Literary or artistic works will remain the property of the Australian Olympic Committee, and where appropriate will be published in official publications.
